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
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

INTRODUCTON AND BACKGROUND

Little Angels Nursery and Primary School is a school that was established in 2002 with one pupil, **Aine Timothy** the son to Director **Kanyesigye Patience** in her home, not forgetting **Rodgers Niwagaba** son to **Dr. Niwagaba, Isaac Akampurira** the son to **Ms Komuhangi Doreen** and **Vision Tumwesigye**, the son to **Mrs Akandeeba Deborah**, who later joined and all in the hands of **Teacher Susan** (May Her Soul Rest in Peace). With only two pupils in boarding section, **Namara Judith** and **Simon Musiime** in Director Patience's home as a dormitory.

Still in that year, the school started working officially as a private day and boarding primary school. The school has a dedicated management team that comprises of three Directors; **Ms Kanyesigye Patience**, who is the founding director of the school, **Ms Tumubweine Annie Bagira** who came in to give technical knowledge about schools and not forgetting **Mr. Niwagaba Alfred**, who was the first head teacher, Little Angels started to rise and shine.

It is located along Kobugabe Road, just **500M** from Ntungamo Town, Ntungamo Municipality, Ntungamo district, South Western Uganda. It is licensed and registered with the Ministry of Education and Sports, Registration number **PPS/L/52**.

The school also started with a well thought mission **“To provide an integrated education environment with love, support and joy in order to nurture the growth and potential abilities of each child irrespective of their special needs”**.

As a school with mixed gender (boys and girls), we set out an informed school motto “Preparing for

the future” to act as an integral guideline towards achieving our dreams. In addition to that, Little Angels' vision statement (**To promote good morals and quality education**) has clearly impacted our learners to develop their steadfastness academically, socially and spiritually. We also strive to ensure that the child reach his/her all round potential in a supportive and safe learning environment.

The School comprises of 51 Staff members, three directors, one administrator, twenty-six teaching staff and twenty-one non-teaching staff. The school has the enrolment of 680 learners, 331 girls and 349 boys.

The school has tremendously continued to offer co-curricular activities that are geared to creating self-esteem and confidence among children through participating in tours, exchange visits with sister schools in debating and other activities, scripture union and drama.

OUR MISSION:

SOWIPA'S overall mission is to "promote pro-people economic growth policies and build local demand for accountability and good governance in South Western Uganda".

OUR VISION

SOWIPA's vision is "To see the emergence of economically dynamically and politically active communities in South Western Uganda". SOWIPA's policy advocacy work helps to address the declining education standards, depressing health care conditions and deteriorating environmental conditions and climate change in the sub-region. We help local communities to access key economic resources such as micro- credit and advisory services and monitor the growth and functioning of civil society in the focus districts of South Western Uganda.

OUR OBJECTIVES:

- ◆ Undertaking evidence- based research to advocate for pro-people policies with particular emphasis on Education, Health, Agriculture, Environment and Human Rights.
- ◆ Providing brokerage services to increase access to micro-credit and other financial services for local community partners and individuals.

2. Local Government performance assessment, Budget analysis, and monitoring program. This project seeks to independently monitor sectoral budget



allocations at the district level including tracking of financial allocations from the central government. The project also seeks to monitor and assess the performance of local councils and the general political arm in South Western Uganda. Information from this project is used to create and increase public demand for accountability on local government officials.

3. Micro-finance brokerage services initiatives: Under this program, SOWIPA will proactively seek to identify and connect community groups to essential micro-credit services. SOWIPA plays a role to advocate for key micro lending organizations such as Village Enterprise Fund, Kiva, Micro-Place to start lending communities and individuals in the target districts. In some of the cases, SOWIPA may become the Responsible party or the mentor for potential recipients.

4. Governance, Human Rights and Advocacy SOWIPA has continually mobilized citizens

in the region to know about their civic rights and responsibilities. In partnership with Local Governments, SOWIPA organizes advocacy meetings, Citizens Parliaments and Civic Education Clinics with the purpose of bridging the gap between leaders and citizens at all levels to discuss on different governance issues mainly in Education, Health, Agriculture, Environment and Human Rights. This approach creates an upward demand for accountability which is the only way to improve Service Delivery in achieving Uganda's Vision 2040.





Furthermore, considering the broadest, most effective impact over the longest period of time and from an educational standpoint, religious ethics are far superior to the rest in our school.



Why Stanbic Bank invests in Uganda's education sector

generated. Just over 500 businesses are already on the ground and running.

We believe that once they step into secondary school, pupils of Little Angels Nursery and Primary School here in Ntungamo will be exposed to the benefits of this programme.

Beyond these efforts, Stanbic has over the years provided other solutions to parents and schools to achieve their dreams.

For instance, in January this year, the Bank announced the immediate availability of UGX60 billion in hugely discounted 'booster financing' to the education sector.
